Guide to Removing Body Spillages

Preparation of the Area

- Assemble equipment as listed below and put out any necessary warning signs, this is especially important since now there is a health risk involved.

How to Remove Body Spillage Cleaning Advice

- Apply the absorbing powder or use paper towels to absorb the spillage.
- Use a mop or scraper to transfer the waste into a clearly marked waste Bio hazard sack.
- Apply a diluted disinfectant to the spillage and leave for a few minutes.
- With a mop or disposable cloth remove the disinfectant and repeat again with a clean cloth and solution.
- Leave the area to air dry.
- Remember to dispose of the waste sack in an approved area such as a biochemical waste bin, which will be burnt later for safe disposal.
- Disinfect all equipment used and leave to air dry.
- Return equipment to store room.
- Wash hands with an antibacterial soap.

- Disposable Scoop
- Disposable Mop / Cloth
- Bucket
- Caution Signage

- Gloves
- Face Mask
- Goggles
- Disposable Apron
- Rubber Gloves

Products Required:

- Paper Towels


- Disinfectant
- Biohazard Waste Sack
- Absorbing Powder
- Antibacterial Soap
